- 1. Students in O2 will be enrolled in two O2 courses in grades 10. The O2 students choose their other 6 courses as they wish. (The O2 students are not together in every class in grade 10)**
- 2. O2 students can take both Skilled Trades and O2**
- 3. The O2 program is a 3 year program and requires commitment as there is a limited enrollment of 20 students and student who complete the O2 program will receive a priority seat (if they wish) in a program at NSCC.**
- 4. Due to scheduling issues students cannot be enrolled in French Immersion and O2.**
- 5. There will be an information session on O2 for parents on March 24th following the general course information session at ESDH beginning at 7:00pm**
